## Assam govt. to be sworn in on Sun.

GAUHATI, March 10: The first non-Congress ministry in Assam headed by Mr. Golap Borbora will be sworn in by the governor, Mr. L. P. Singh, at Dispur, the temporary capital, here on Sunday.

Mr. Borbora, who returned here this afternoon from New Delhi after consultations with the Janata party high command about the formation of the ministry, told newsmen at Borjhar airport that the 14-member ministry would be 2-tier — cabinet and minister of state.

He said a number of parliamentary secretaries would also be inducted.

In the 126-member house, the Janata party has a strength of 58, including five independents. Besides its ally, the PTCA has a strength of five, while, the CPM and the RCPI, which have extended their support to Janata party, have got 11 and four, respectively.—Saniachar.
