Disturbed Areas Declared

GAUHATI, March 3—The Government of Assam by a notification issued on February 27, have declared the entire Cachar, Karbi Anglong, N C Hills districts and eleven Reserve Forests of Sibsagar District namely Nambar, Rengma, Dayang, Kakadonga, Dessoi Valley, Dessoi, Tiru, Geleki, Abhayapur, Dilli and Diphu as disturbed areas in view of the depredations of armed gangs of hostiles.

Further some areas in Sibsagar district falling outside the Reserve Forest areas mentioned above such as the areas within the jurisdiction of the Golaghat and Sarupathar Police Stations lying between an imaginary line running parallel to the N E Frontier Railway line, two miles to the north of the Railway line and the Assam-Nagaland Boundary on the east and the areas within the jurisdiction of the Titabar, Teok, Marioni, Amguri, Nazira and Sonari Police Stations lying between an imaginary line running parallel to the N E Frontier Railway line, two miles to the North of the Railway line and the Assam Nagaland Boundary on the south have also been declared as disturbed areas.
