## Assam CLP leader wants to resign

GAUHATI, Nov. 24**—The leader of the Assam Congress Legislature Party, Mr S. C. Sinha, former Chief Minister, has formally sought to be relieved of his post.

Mr Sinha, who has kept himself aloof from the move taken by 19 of his colleagues in the State Assembly seeking unity with the Congress (I), is backed by three CLP members in his reluctance to support Mrs India Gandhi's unity call.

There are 24 Congress MLAs in the House.

The 19 MLAs who want unity have sought Mr Swaran Singh's initiative in the matter.

A leading member of the group said today that the decision was "individual" but conveyed to Mr Swaran Singh "collectively."
