

NEW CHIEF OF ASSAM JANATA KAKOTI REPLACES BARBORA

NEW DELHI, Friday.—Mr Robin Kakoti was today nominated president of the Assam Janata Party in place of Mr Golap Barbora, who has become Chief Minister.

Mrs Renuka Devi Barkataki, Union Minister of State for Education, has been appointed treasurer.
