

Hegde studies Assam JLP dissensions

GAUHATI, March 13: Mr. R. K. Hegde, general secretary of the Janata party, who arrived here on Sunday along with Mrs. Renuka Devi Barkataki, Union minister of state, to study the situation created by the dissidents' demand for a change in leadership of the Assam JLP, left for New Delhi yesterday.

He said he would submit his report to the party chief, Mr. Chandra Shekhar, in a day or two.

He told newsmen that the dissidents wanted the high command to direct the chief minister, Mr. Golap Borbora, to seek a vote of confidence.

The two observers met several dissidents both individually and collectively. He discounted reports in some circles that Mrs. Barkataki might replace Mr. Borbora.
