Janata Dissidents In Assam Divided

GAUHATI, July 29.—Dissidents in the Janata Legislature Party appear to differ on the formation of an Assam Janata Party, reports PTI.

At least, three dissidents MLAs have so far opposed the decision of the dissident leader, Mr Tarni Mohan Baruah, who announced yesterday that 21 MLAs had resigned from Janata to form a new party to provide an alternative Government in the State.

Mr Debananda Bora and Mr Tarini Das of the dissident faction in a separate statements said today that the formation of a regional party would not serve any purpose. Another prominent dissident MLA, Mr Nagen Sarma, yesterday described the move as unfortunate.

The Chief Minister, Mr Golap Borbora, has already made an appeal to the dissidents for an amicable settlement.
