## All set for Borbora ouster

SHILLONG, Aug. 18.

Gauhati was today in the grip of a feverish political activity designed to topple the 27-month-old Janata Ministry headed by Mr. Golap Borbora.

The detractors of the Chief Minister claimed that they had already collected 63 signatures on a memorandum to be submitted to Governor L. P. Singh, urging him to advise Mr. Borbora to summon a special session of the Assembly for a trial of strength.

The memorandum would be submitted to the Secretary to the Governor at Dispur tomorrow morning.

Mr. Tarini Barooah, leaders of the pro-changers, claimed that another Janata legislator had decided to resign from the primary membership of the party.

He said besides the 21 Janata dissidents, the 23-member Congress group, seven-strong Congress (I), 6-member CPI and six-strong Peoples Democratic Front (of Independents), had already committed to support their move to form an alternative Government.
