

Khar Sing Bey Resigns From Karbi Anglong Dist Council

DIPHU, Sept. 26—Sri Khar Sing Bey, Chief Executive Member, Karbi Anglong District Council, tendered his resignation on September 24 just two hours before the General Session of the District Council was due to begin.

Sri Bey tendered his resignation to the Governor of Assam and this was disclosed by Sri Mangal Sing Engti (Chairman, District Council, Diphu, in the house.

Sri Bey, Chief Executive Member had stated that he had submitted his resignation due to political crisis in the party itself and his resignation letter was forwarded to the Governor of Assam by the Chairman with recommendation for acceptance.

Later, the Chairman declared the session of the District Council adjourned without transacting any business as scheduled earlier till the instructions are received from the Governor in the matter of acceptance of resignation of the Chief Executive Member.

It may be mentioned that as per rules of the District Council Sri Bey will continue as Chief Executive Member till his resignation is accepted and alternative arrangement is made. It may be mentioned that Sri Bey was elected on Janata ticket from Rongkhang constituency and was elected leader of the House.
