

## Muslim League Leaders

### Join Cong (i)

GAUHATI, Sept 8—Sri Abdul Muhibb Mazumdar President of the Eastern Zonal Muslim League, has resigned from the presidency of the party and as also from the membership of the party. Along with Sri Mazumdar Dr. Emran Hus-sain Choudhury, Ex MLA, Vice-President of Eastern Zonal Muslim, Sri Shamsul Huda, Office Secretary of the League have also resigned for the Muslim League. The main reason among others for the resignation of Sri Mazumdar, is his difference of opinion with the Indian Union Muslim League over the question of support to the civil disobedience movement started by the Jamiat-ul-Ulama i-Hind against the atrocities on the Muslims, in which the Indian Union Muslim League refused to take part or offer its support.

Sri Mazumdar and his other colleagues have joined Congress (I) as, according to them India has been brought to a state of total political and economic bankruptcy and complete break down of law and order by two years of Janata 'mis-rule' and the immediate and foremost need of the time is to have a strong and efficient Government, to bring stability in the country and build up its credibility before the world community.

According to an APCC (I) Press release. The Biplobi Janata Congress a regional Political Party of Cachar District, has joined with Congress (I).
