

# No cabinet expansion

SILCHAR, MARCH 4.—The Assam Chief Minister, Mr. Golap Barbor, ruled out the possibility of any immediate expansion or reorganisation of the cabinet as demanded by the dissident Janata MLAs.

Talking to newsmen here yesterday evening, he said the Janata high command also had made it clear that it was not in favour of such expansion or reorganisation.

The Chief Minister, now to, said that the high command had impressed on him that the cabinet strength could not be more than 10 per cent of the total strength of the House as recommended by administrative reforms committee.

Referring to the Assam Nagaland border dispute he said he would meet his Nagaland counterpart, Mr. Vizol, in Kohima just after the end of the current Assembly session.
