

No-trust move against Borbora govt. planned

SHILLONG, August 25: The Assam assembly will meet on September 3 for a crucial session and on the very opening day a no-confidence motion against the one-and-a-half-year-old Borbora ministry is reportedly planned by the rebels of the Janata legislature party from which they have resigned, reducing the ruling Janata party's strength in the 126-member house to 40.

Some of the rebels, who have been offered berths in the reconstituted ministry, are, however, expected to return to the party fold.

It was officially learnt here yesterday that Mr. Golap Borbora advised the governor, Mr. L. P. Singh, to summon the assembly to meet on September 3. An official announcement in this regard is expected shortly.
