

Plea For United Left Front In Assam

GAUHATI, Sept. 14—Three against these twin evil forces. Left parties of Assam namely CPI (M), SUCI and RSP have given a clarion call for forging a united front of the left and democratic parties in Assam to fight the ensuing Lok Sabha poll.
