

President Arrives In Tezpur Today

NEW DELHI, Feb. 4.—President Sanjiva Reddy will arrive in Tezpur on February 5 by an Indian Air Force plane on an eight-day visit to the north-eastern States.

He will be received at Chaloni airport by Mr Golap Borbora, Chief Minister of Assam, and civil and military officials.

The President will not attend any official or public function at Tezpur but will fly to Shillong where he will attend a public reception in the evening.

This will be Mr Reddy's first visit to the North-eastern States after he became President. In the Shillong helipad, the President will be received by Mr L. P. Singh, Governor of the north-eastern States, and Meghalaya Cabinet members.

Several delegations, particularly from the minority communities, are expected to present memoranda to the President highlighting the grievances of non-tribals in Meghalaya.

On February 6, the President will go to Aizawl and the following day he will visit Agartala and Imphal. He will leave for Kohima on February 8.

He will reach Itanagar in Arunachal Pradesh on February 9, where he will spend three days. He will leave Tezpur on February 12, from where he will fly to Delhi.
