

Borbora may 2 drop aides

GAUHATI, April 20.

THE Assam chief minister, Mr. Golap Borbora, indicated yesterday that he might drop some members of his cabinet and reshuffle the portfolios in view of the recent political developments in the state.

Mr. Borbora said he would endeavour to make the cabinet more effective and cohesive.

Addressing a press conference at Dispute he said ten of the dissidents in the ruling Janata legislature party, who reportedly signed a memorandum asking him to seek a vote of confidence, had withdrawn their signatures and reaffirmed their unstinted support to him.

New Delhi (PTI): Seven dissident members of the Assam Janata legislature party have described as "entirely baseless and misleading" the reported claim of the Assam Chief minister, Mr. Golap Borbora, that ten dissident MLAs had dissociated themselves from the dissident group in writing.
