

# Borbora to meet Central leaders

SHILLONG, Feb. 11.

Assam Chief Minister Golap Chandra Borbora is flying to New Delhi tomorrow to seek the advice of the Central leaders on the growing demand within the ruling Janata Party in Assam for his resignation in view of his alleged failure to effectively deal with the armed Naga raids along the disputed border with Nagaland and the situation arising in the wake of mass killings, violence and arson in the bordering villages on January 5.

Mr. Borbora is scheduled to meet Prime Minister Morarji Desai, Janata Party chief Chandra Shekhar and Defence Minister Jagjivan Ram during his visit to the Capital.

The Assam Janata Legislature Party in its two-day meeting at Dispur on February 4 and 5, witnessed angry exchanges between the supporters and opponents of the Chief Minister and the demand for his resignation was strongly voiced by the dissidents.
