

AASU threatens renewed stir

GAUHATI, Oct. 17 (PTI)

The All Assam Students Union (AASU) tonight warned that it would go for a fresh agitation programmes if the Centre failed to concede its demand for an immediate solution to the foreign nationals problems.

Mr. Prafulla Kumar Mahanta and Mr. Birigu Kumar Phukan, president and general secretary of AASU respectively in a statement alleged that the Centre instead of protecting the genuine Indian minorities have been showing more concern for foreign nationals.

They expressed the hope that the Government would come forward with "sincerity" to solve the Assam problem and not to 'compel' the people of the State to resort to agitation again.

They denied that they had met Mr. Rajiv Gandhi at Dimapur during his recent visit to the north eastern region as reported in a section of the press.
