

# Curbs on NE small units waived

NEW DELHI, JULY 11.—  
The government has decided to waive the restrictions on new units that are being established in the small sector in the north-eastern region.

This decision was taken at a meeting of the All India Small Scale Industries Board held here recently.

It was also decided to set up a high-level standing committee under the chairmanship of Mr Charanjit Chana, Union Minister of State for Industry, to monitor the progress of recommendations made at the board meeting at the central and state levels.

The committee will also keep a watch on the programmes of the small industry sector, particularly in relation to credit, raw materials and sick units.

Special emphasis was made on the requirements of the north-eastern region and other backward areas at the meeting. It recommended the formulation of a comprehensive policy for such areas with special reference to hill areas, desert and drought-prone regions.
