H. K. Bhattacharyya
Ordered To Be
Released On Parole

GUWAHATI, Oct. 15—
Sri Hiranya Kumar Bhat-
tacharyya, DIG of Police,
Assam, since dismissed
from service, was ordered
to be released on parole
by the Supreme Court
yesterday, according to an
information received here.

The Counsel for the
Government of Assam,
however, sought an ad-
journment of the hearing
without releasing him on
parole.

Sri Bhattacharyya, how-
ever, did not pray for re-
lease on parole.

Sri Bhattacharyya, who
was detained under the
NSA, has presently been
lodged in the Guwahati
Jail. He is expected to be
released tomorrow after
receipt of the Supreme
Court order, according to
the District Jail sources
here.

Kumud Gogoi, Hemen Das Ma-
dhu Baishya, Dilip Chakraborty
and Prabin Mahanta who
sacrificed their lives during
the mass movement on foreign-
ers issue.

This was decided here by
the Co-ordination Committee
of the Sadou Asom Karma-
chari Parishad the All Assam
Central Semi-Central Karma-
chari Parishad, the Asom
Bidyut Karmi Karna Pari-
shad, the Sadou Asom San-
kari Nigam and Pratisthan
Karmi Federation, the Sadou
Asom Bank Karmachari Pari-
shad and the Sadou Asom
Be-Sarkari Karmachari Pari-
shad.

A statement issued by the
Co-ordination Committee that
all Zila (Sub-divisional) and
Anchalik units of the Pari-
shads will jointly observe the
day in their respective areas
by establishing a 'Swahid
Bedi' in a common place. As
