

# AASU Convention Approves Draft Proposals

From Our Correspondent BONGAIGAON, Oct 4.— The convention of the Assam Students Union held in the Bongaigaon College premises under the presidentship of Sri Prafulla Kumar Mahanta on October 2 and 3 last, endorsed the draft proposals submitted to the Central Government last week.

The convention also discussed the organizational matters.

The convention decided to hold rallies in different places and a Central rally at Guwahati by November 10 next.

A public meeting was also organized here today by the Bongaigaon Anchalik Chhatra Santha. Addressing the meeting, Sri Mahanta urged upon the people of Assam to get ready for the next phase of non-violent agitational programme if the Central Government do not come forward for a negotiated settlement within a week on the basis of the

draft proposals submitted by AASU and AAGSP. Sri Mahanta further appealed to the people to resist the pro-foreigners' forces trying to destroy the movement.

Sri Bharat Narah Sri Nurul Hussain, Sri Deepak Das, Sri Kiran Deka and Sri Chanakya Das also spoke in the meeting.

The meeting was presided over by Sri Deben Sarma, President Bongaigaon Anchalik GSP.
