

AASU Draft Proposals Endorsed

GAUHATI, Sept. 5.—The State-level convention of the All Assam Students Union, which concluded on Saturday at Bongaigaon, about 200 km from here, has reportedly endorsed the draft proposals submitted to the Centre for a solution to the foreign-nationals issue, reports UNI.

The two-day convention, which was attended by representatives from different units of AASU, also decided to hold rallies all over the State, including a central rally at Gauhati by November 20, sources close to AASU said here today.

Assam Opposition Leaders' Demand

GAUHATI, Oct. 5.—Leaders of 10 Opposition parties in Assam today demanded that the Centre expedite the process of reaching a solution to the foreign nationals problem and keep the people informed of the results of discussions so far held with the Assam agitation leaders, reports PTI.

In a statement here the leaders accused the Centre of adopting "dilatatory tactics by prolonging the discussion" and expressed their resentment over "keeping the political parties and the people completely in the dark about its outcome".

They said the solution to the issue should be on the basis of the Constitution, relevant laws, international agreement and national commitments.
