



*AJYCP member Ananta Kalita, the 'live-evidence'
of Police involvement in 'Secret Killing'*

The mysterious 'secret killing' by the surrendered ULFA militants patronised by the government has become a common incident for the people of Assam. It is to be mentioned here that the United Liberation Front of Assam (ULFA) was formed in 1979 to operate as an armed organisation to liberate Assam from the colonial regime of India. In the year 1992, around 2000 ULFA activists surrendered to the State Government, still many cadres remained active displaying their activities with a double strength. So the government started using surrendered ULFA militants to liquidate the activities of ULFA.

Initially only a section of SULFA were used by the government and a transaction was made between the Government and SULFA which included locating ULFA hide-outs and identifying the arrested militants in lieu of performing every heinous illegal activities in the state. Though majority of SULFA started a normal life, they were always compelled by the police and army to join the anti-ULFA operation. In consequence ULFA militants attacked some SULFA members who were involved in anti-ULFA operation, resulting in the formation of organised groups of SULFA, which sneaked into different parts of the state, equipped with sophisticated arms provided by Army as well as Police. They were also provided police security. Till 1996 the conflict was between ULFA and SULFA, though some innocent people were harassed or threatened, but none was killed. The first incident of killing took place on 17 May 1996. The founder Secretary General of MASS and a renowned and noted journalist Mr. Parag Kumar Das was brutally killed in broad day-light in the capital city Guwahati. The AGP Government revealed that one SULFA leader was responsible for the killing, but from different evidential information the involvement of the then city police chief (SP) came to light and was published in local newspaper. The both accused, the SULFA leader and the police SP are still absconding. This barbaric incident of killing a popular and noted journalist created a deep anguish among all sections of people and wide spread protest prevailed in the state that

was never seen before. Mere denials of its involvement in such barbaric episode cannot absolve the Government and the police of its alleged role in this macabre drama. The Police-SULFA nexus is an accepted fact of life today. The secret killings which has been stopped for some time, revived again in the mid of 1997. This time the miscreants established camps in some secret places including Guwahati and expanded their groups. During the General election of 1998, ULFA killed some members of the AGP Government accusing them as betrayer. The army chief of ULFA Mr. Paresh Baruah alleged that the ruling AGP government violated the pre-election contract with ULFA. Consequently the state Government started the 'Secret Killing' of innocent people whom they thought as supporter or symphathiser of ULFA or who protested against the Government. The state police is being directly used by the Government to counter the political oponent. Such state sponsored terrorism cannot be tolerated at any cost.

The secret killing loomed at large after the killing of a SULFA leader Mr. Tapan Dutta on August 10 of 1998 at Guwahati by ULFA. In retaliation to the killing of Mr. Tapan Dutta, the killer gangs of surrendered ULFA militants killed many of the family members of the top-ranking ULFAs including chairman and its publicity secretary. A few instances of such killings are mentioned below :

(1) On August 11, 1998, two motor cycle borne SULFA killed Mr. Dimba Rajkonwar (55), the elder brother of ULFA's chairman Mr. Rajib Rajkonwar @ Aurobindra Rajkova who is an employee of Assam State Transport Corporation (ASTC), inside his office complex at ASTC Chowkidingi bus stand of Dibrugarh town.

(2) Similarly a group of secret assassins gunned down Mrs. Phuleswari Saikia Das (Head mistress of Barama B.K. Bhandari L.P. School and mother of the ULFA Publicity Secy. Mr. Mithinga Daimary @ Dipak Das, Dr. Bharanidhar Das (District Laprocy Officer, Nalbari and elder brother of Mr. Mithinga), Mrs. Rupjyoti Saikia (Pregnant sister-in-law of Mr. Mithinga) and Ms.

Latika Kachari (a human rights defender and younger sister of Mr. Mithinga)

(3) In the similar manner Mr. Deva Kanta Gogoi, who is an employee of Dibrugarh University was shot dead by the secret killers on 15th August '98 at Barpathar Dighalgaon of Dibrugarh district only because his younger brother Krishna Gogoi is an ULFA leader.

(4) Mr. Harendra Nath Mishra, an employee of production unit of OIL (Oil India Limited), Duliajan and elder brother of ULFA leader Mr. Pradip @ Munnakan Mishra was kidnapped by the secret killer from the residential area of OIL, Duliajan. His multiple injured bullet ridden corpse was recovered by the police next day.

The killing of family members of ULFA was stopped for some days as the ULFA chief threatened the rulling AGP Government to kill AGP leader if they do not stop 'Secret Killing'. But on 7th May it was restarted as a residence of SULFA was attacked. This incident itself a mystry. At around 7 p.m. of 7th May '99 some unidentified miscreants sprayed a rocket propelled grenade (RPG cell) at 'Usha Court Apartment', where a group of SULFA resides. SULFA and Police claimed that it is ULFA who attacked the apartment to kill SULFA members. But ULFA denied their any involvement with the incident. ULFA also demanded that the IGP (Inspector General of Police) operation Mr. Sribastav is behind it. To create tension among ULFA-SULFA, the Police chief played the game. Interestingly, at the time of attack no one was present there and so no one was injured. Immediately after the incident, some armed SULFA cordoned off the 'Usha Courts apartment' along with police and never allowed any person even the photo journalists to enter in to the building by Police and SULFA. After around one hour stay at the building, the higher police officials went away and the SULFA people created a regin of terror killing as many as 9 people in the state. Out of them 8 people are kins of ULFA activist.

(5) It was arround 2.30 am. of 8th March 99 (after a hour

of the incident of Usha Court Apartment) a group of armed people boarding on a Maruti car and three Gypsies, numbered about 20-25 in plain get up and camouflaged dress, knocked the door of Mr. Haren Teron (60) of Lakhara area in Guwahati city. They asked them to open the door saying that they are police personnel and coming for a search operation. The elder son of Mr. Haren is a member of ULFA, so police frequently come to their house in search of his son Mr. Putul Teron. As Mr. Teron opened the door, the group entered into the house and ordered other family members to come out. Mr. Haren, his wife Mrs. Barhani Teronpi(52) and the youngest son Mr. Bipul(20) came out. But Miss Mamani, the lone daughter of Mr. Haren teron hide under a bed. The group had taken all three to their courtyard and ordered them to sit on a bench and opened fire killing all three on the spot. The group went away after the killing. Hearing gunshot, local people came out from their houses and rescued Mamani. The village people informed the Basistha police station and the Ambari Police station about the incident before 4 a.m. over phone. But the Police reached the spot at 9 a.m., though it is 15 minutes journey from the police station.

(6) The same group (as the description of the group and the news reports published in local dailies) arrived village Belguri near Sonapur Air force camp, in the same district and around 30 km far from the spot of first incident. The group knocked the door of Mr. Nirmal Boro, a member of ULFA saying the same that they are Police and coming for search operation. Mrs. Rambha Boro (50), mother of Mr. Nirmal opened the door and the group took Mrs. Rambha, Mr. Kantaram Boro (80) and Mrs. Sukuri Boro (75) grand father and grand mother of Nirmal, to courtyard of the house. The group sprayed out bullets upon them with AK 47 and 9 mm pistol killing Mr. Kantaram and Mrs. Sukuri Boro on the spot and went away. Luckily Mrs. Rambha saved though she received bullet injury at her arms. She revealed that she could identify some of the assailants as they had come to her house along with her ULFA son Nirmal before surrendering

and even she had served them with food for several times.

(7) On 9 March'99, at around 2 am. next day night of the Belguri and Lakhara incident, Mr. Dhaneswar Rava (62) and Mr. Sushila Rava (36) father and mother of an ULFA activist Manoj Rava, was killed in the same way at Belpara under Rangjuli police station in Goalpara district, around 60 KM from Guwahati city. After the killing the group attacked the belly of the dead body of Mrs. Sushila with sharp weapons.

(8) Moreover, just after few hours of the 'Usha Court' incident a group of SULFA led by one SULFA Dibakar Deba burnt down the house of top ULFA leader Mr. Tapan Baruah at BaliKuchi in Nalbari district, nearly 50 km. from Guwahati city. By the time of the incident the members of the house were away to safer places. The group beaten chowkider of the Rice Mill, own by the family and pour patrol at the granary and caught fire. The group fired indiscriminately at the house and thrown a grenade at the 'Kali' temple at their residence and went back to Guwahati.

(9) Next day on 8 March, '99, the same group boarding on a white Maruti and three red Maruti came from Guwahati, stopped at Sonamati chowk of the National Highway in Nalbari district and fired upon Mr. Biren Das (28) who was watching repairing of a technically troubled truck in front of the people present there. In that firing Mr. Biren Das(28), brother of a ULFA activist Nipul Das, was died on the spot and another one Biren Das (32) a rickshaw puller of that area got serious injury and admitted to Guwahati medical College, where he succumbed to his injury next day.

Killing of this 9 person and demolishing the house took place before the eyes of the Police and Army. Even after the first two incident of 7th night, the police administration and the army, spread over the whole state, never take any steps to stop the group and allowed them to carry out next phase at the night of 8th March. The area where all these incidents happens is full of police camps, CRPF camps, army camps and in many roads

to those places of incidents, usually police and Army put several "Check Post", but during the three days of the terror, there was no check post either by Police or by Army. But after three days, when MASS investigation team visited those places have to face many 'Check' by Police and CRPF.

In one of our printed report 'Killing of Human Rights defender in Assam' we documented some cases of 'Extra Judicial Killing' where the involvement of Police and Army can clearly noticed. We repeat here one incident.

(10) On 4th April '99 around 1-30 am an armed group of about 15, cordoned off the house of Mr. Nripen Sarma(30), chairman of the local unit of MASS, at Dharamtala under Patacharkuchi P.S. in Barpeta District. The group called Nripen to open the door and identified them as police from Patacharkuchi P.S. Mr. Nripen and his sister Miss Hiran Devi opened the door and seen some musked armed people along with Mr. Jitmol Doley, the Sub-Divisional Police Officer and Mr. Nagen Bora the Officer-in-charge of Patacharkuchi P.S. The two officer made a search of his house and beaten him asking about ULFA organisation in front of his sister. After the search the group went away taking Nripen along with them and asked the family to come to the police station next morning. When next morning Miss Hiran went to the Police Station, the Police denied his arrest and expressed ignorance about him. Helpless family members of Mr. Nripen, some villagers and the local units of AJYCP, a youth organisation and the Bazar (Market) comittee met the Sub-Divisional officer, the Deputy Commissioner of the District and submitting memorendum, requested them to take immediate steps for his recovery. Consequently, the dead body of Mr. Nripen recovered from a nearby place.

After the recovery of the dead body, the agitated people cordoned the police station and the family members also claimed in front of the MASS investigation team and in presence of the Asst. Superintendent of Police that the Police led by SDPO Jitmol Doley and OC Nagen Bora picked up Nripen from his house.

But Mr. Jitmol Doley, SDPO who was also present there tried to convinced the mob saying that he is innocent and one SULFA leader Tirtha Bhuyan is responsible for the killing. They got information and could collect evidence and they will take immediate steps. Till now, after 5 months of the incident no steps were taken. The government instead of taking any steps against the guilty Police Officer, promoted him to Addl. Superintendent of Police as a award of the killing of Nripen Sarma. Mr. Jitmol Doley is also directly involved with some more extra Judicial killing of some ULFA members there.

Now, the secret killer group comprising police and army personnel created such an atmosphere of terror that the family members of top ULFA leader as well as NDFB leader, afraid to stay at their own houses. Very recently, the 'Secret Killer' group adopt a new policy of blasting the houses of ULFA or NDFB leader.

Very recently, on 12 September '99 another handiwork of 'Secret Killer'claimed 4 lives of a family at Kakatibari in Sibsagar district. It is alleged by the police that ULFA activists used to take shelter at the house of Mr. Uma Kanta Gogoi and one of his daughter had a good relation with one ULFA Mr. Jatin Phukan, who was killed in cool blood by the group of police and 'Secret Killer' on the night of 9 Sept.'99 after kidnapping him from a nearby house of Uma Gogoi. On 10th Sept. morning, Police published that Jatin Phukan died in an encounter and they recovered some materials from his possession including one 'Land-mine'. When the Police Chief of the district Mr. P.K. Lohia, administrated the mine, accidently blasted killing the Police Chief, two Journalist, one army officer and one constable inside the office of the S.P. Sibsagar. After one day of this incident, on 12 Sept. night, the Secret Killer group blasted the house of Mr. Uma Gogoi, killing him and his three daughters with mine to liquidate the proof of the alleged killing of ULFA Jatin, which the police termed as 'encounter'. The post mortem report revealed that the four victims were shot dead before blasting. The local

villagers also says it to the news person that they heard the sound of coming Maruti vehicle to the village and also heard some sound of gunshot before the blasting.

MASS and some other organisation like AJYCP claimed it repeatedly that the so-called 'Secret Killer' is nothing but a group of SULFA, Police and army personnel and they wants to create a panic situation by killing family members of ULFA and other innocent people who raised voice against HR violation, whom they stamps as 'ULFA supporter' and the government run this operation as a part of their 'anti-insurgency' operation. But it is really very difficult to proof the nexus, when the government-the police itself involved in such case. But, it is 18th September '1999, which a significant day, because the day brought out the nexus of Police and Secret Killer to lime light. On the night of 16th Sept. '99 Mr. Ananta Kalita, member of AJYCP, kidnapped by the so-called 'Secret Killer' from his house at Kalitapara under Hajo police station in Kamrup district, about 30 k.m. from the Guwahati city. The Group started beating him at his residence and forcibly took him away on their vehicle. At the morning of 19 Sept. '99 bullet injured Ananta came to the Maligaon office of AJYCP (Assam Jatiayatabadi Yuba Chatra Parishad, a youth organisation) and the members of AJYCP admitted him to Guwahati Medical college where from he was shifted to first Neurological Reacherch Center and later downtown Hospital for better treatment. In the hospital Mr. Ananta Kalita, who received his bullet injury on his head told the Journalist, the police officials and the physicians that he was picked up from his house by a group of Police and SULFA and taken to a Assam Police Battalion camp situated at Kahilipara in the capital city Guwahati. He was kept there up to the evening of 18th Sept. and tortured inhumanely asking about some ULFA member. He also revealed that he was earlier arrested by police in false charges and after his release on bail, the officer in charge of Hajo Police Station, threat him either to surrender as ULFA or to join the youth wing of the rulling AGP party, otherwise his life will be in danger. But

Ananta denied to surrender, because, as he says, he is not a member of ULFA, nor working for them, and also denied to join the youth wing of AGP.

On the night of 18 September, Mr. Ananta was taken to the Jorabat police station about 25 k.m. from the city and the group stopped their vehicle in front of the Jorabat police station and keeping him on the vehicle, the group entered in to the P.S. and came out after some time. Then he was taken to a nearby hillock, where some more armed people, some of whom he described as police personnel, are waiting there. After the group discussed something there, a drunk armed person pull him to a slope of the hill and shooting him on his head with his pistol, pushed him to the slope. He was luckily saved though the bullet passed through his mouth. Pushing him to the slope, the killer shot some more rounds of bullets, which never hurt Ananta. Injured Ananta lost his sense there and recovered at around 4 A.M. of 19 Sept. and somehow could come to the nearby highway and from there with the help of others he reach Maligaon AJYCP office.

The news spread out like fire and all section of people condemned the incident and demanded the dismissal of the Government which is directly involved with 'secret killing'. In a citizen protest meeting convened by AJYCP at Guwahati on 21 Sept '99, different organisation including political parties like Cong(I), BJP, URMCA, AGSP and other non-political organisations, intellectuals, Journalists, Lawyers associations condemn the nexus between the so called 'Secret Killer' and the Police-Government. The citizen meeting resolve to demand immediate dismissal of the 'Killer Government' and call for a state-wide bandh (Total clossure) on 24th September. The 'Bandh' was observed peacefully by all section of people.

Though the Hajo police registered a case of kidnapping before Ananta came back and also the Dispur P.S. of Guwahati city registered another case on the basis of a written complain by Mr. Ananta, the police did not take any action in to the matter.

The district administration first declared a Magisterial inquiry and latter the Government declared a "Judicial inquiry", but till the filling of this report no initiative towards any investigation has been made.

Before the case of Mr. Ananta Kalita, two another members of AJYCP was killed by the so-called 'Secret Killer'.

(a) Mr. Kalimuddin Ahmed (32), member of AJYCP and final year student of Post Graduate at Guwahati University resides at Maligaon Gosala in the Capital city Guwahati. On 21 September '98 around 1.40 am 7 gunman in plain get up, who introducing themselves as army personnel picked up Kalimuddin from his residence. Next day his dead body was recovered from Betkuchi near Garchowk in the Guwahati city.

(b) Mr. Ainul Hoque Choudhury (30), a member of AJYCP, resident of a village near Hajo was picked up by some unidentified gunmen, suspected to be 'Secret Killer' from his residence in the night of 21 December'98. Next day his dead body was found from Panikhaiti area, a outskirts of Guwahati city. The corpse bore multiple injury and 11 marks of gunshot.

Now the question is, if in a democratic country like India, Government directly sponsored a civil killer group to kill innocent people who opposed the Governmental policy one or in another way and if the 'peace keeper' - Law enforcement authority directly involved in the 'Secret Killing' with other criminals, how the people will survive? From whom they will seek security? And how human rights organisation like MASS, can work for the protection and promotion of human rights or civil rights?
