The Kamrup District Garo National Council most emergently submit this most humble memorandum reiterating our Continuing Demand to solve our anguishful problem in connection with the above-cited subject.

INTRODUCTORY

In the present generation, the Garos of this sector of Assam state have constituted some Garo Organizations such as: GARO NATIONAL COUNCIL; ALL ASSAM GARO UNION; ALL ASSAM GARO SAHITYA SABHA; ALL ASSAM GARO STUDENTS' UNION; ALL ASSAM GARO SCHOOL TEACHERS' ASSOCIATION; GARO WOMEN FEDERATION etc. who hold some common as well as some diversified AIMS and objects: And of these organizations, the Garo National Council (the G.N.C.) is the most comprehensive and main political organization of the Region since the past British Regime in India and it often supports as well as opposes the Government's Political Policies as per necessity according to the situations.

PRESENT CONCERN

Our Kamrup-Goalpara Zonal Garo National Council has been opposing and demanding to delete the Garo villages from the Rabha Hasong sketch Map (Vide our GNC's joint Memorandum dated the 9th August, 1994 onward continually which we reiterate herewith as well unanimously and strongly for the sympathy of the Govts. of Assam and India.
